The reason for this was reiterated yesterday by Victoria's Chief Health Officer, Dr Brett Sutton, who stated:

"My advice to the Victorian Government was and continues to be that to slow the spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19), schools should undertake remote learning for term two.

This is because having around a million children and their parents in closer contact with teachers and other support staff has the potential to increase cases of Coronavirus not just in schools but across the community.

By having remote learning, it can contribute to physical distancing and therefore supports efforts to drive transmission down."

The transition into Term 2 has not been easy for anyone, but we should be reassured there is a very good reason to be taking this significant step.

Learning from Home

Thank you once again for the cooperation that all families have shown with the changes that we have been required to put in place to assist the health and safety of the whole community. I have said this every time I have sent updates home to families, but I truly mean it as I understand that for many families this is very difficult. 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Learning at School

Despite what the Prime Minister has said, Belvoir Special School is a Victorian Government School and Victorian Government School policy is for all students to learn at home if possible. We do understand that there are a small number of students who may need to be at school due to parents working or they are at risk being at home. Due to Health reasons there are a number of staff who are unable to attend the school at all. Therefore, we have a limited number of staff on hand to work in the classrooms each day and we are rostering different staff in and out on a daily basis. In order to ensure we have enough staff at school parents are required to complete an application to attend school request each fortnight. These applications need to be completed before the next week so that a roster can be established.

Requests for weeks 3 and 4 of term (27th April to 9th May) will open on Monday and will close at 9:00am Thursday 23rd of April. Those families who are already accessing the school will also need to complete a new request form. These will be sent home with your child from Monday.

Please be aware that there is increased risk for both staff and students with regard to Coronavirus as the school has not got any protective equipment as yet. We have increased the amount of cleaning and
